

Alberta Lake Management Society STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

The Alberta Lake Management Society (ALMS) invites students to apply for the 14th annual scholarship established to assist students who conduct research or studies that aid the management of lakes and their watersheds.

Who is eligible?

Full time senior undergraduate or graduate students enrolled in disciplines related to lake or watershed management.

What's the criteria?

A scholarship review committee appointed by the Board of Directors will consider academic achievement, financial need, major field of study, a statement of career goals, and relevance of the course of study to the objectives of ALMS.

How much is the award?

A single scholarship of \$2000 will be awarded for a one-year period.

Application Deadline

Applicants must submit the scholarship application form to the review committee of the ALMS no later than **May 30, 2016**.

Notification of Recipient

The scholarship recipient will be notified by July 1st. The recipient will be expected to address the Annual General Meeting in September and present a progress report on research undertaken, or another topic of mutual interest.
