Scholarship Qualifications:

- Enrolled in a graduate or undergraduate program in September of the scholarship year.
- Enrolled at a Canadian university or college.
- Studying aquatic sciences or a related discipline.

Your Application should contain the following components:

Personal Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name • Academic institution, department, and program • Contact information (phone, e-mail address, mailing address) • Type of applicant (Ph.D., M.Sc., M.A., Undergraduate, Technical) • Program commencement date • Anticipated program completion date
Academic Achievement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please submit a transcript of marks for courses taken (draft transcripts acceptable). • List any academic achievements including awards and scholarships. • List any relevant courses yet to be taken in your program.
Application Relevance (500 Word Maximum)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tell us why you are an excellent candidate for this scholarship. • What are your career objectives? • How does your application align with the objectives of the Alberta Lake Management Society? • How does your project inform or relate to aspects of lake/watershed management? • Describe relevant work or volunteer experience.
Research Topic (Two Page Maximum)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Project title • Project supervisor • Project description, including: background, research objectives, methods, schedule, significance.
