Your Application should contain the following components:

Academic Achievement	<ul> <li>Please submit a transcript of marks for courses taken (draft transcripts acceptable).</li> <li>List any academic achievements including awards and scholarships.</li> <li>List any relevant courses yet to be taken in your program.</li> </ul>
Application Relevance (500 Word Maximum)	<ul> <li>Tell us why you are an excellent candidate for this scholarship.</li> <li>What are your career objectives?</li> <li>How does your application align with the objectives of the Alberta Lake Management Society?</li> <li>How does your project inform or relate to aspects of lake/watershed management?</li> <li>Describe relevant work or volunteer experience.</li> </ul>
Research Topic (Two Page Maximum)	<ul> <li>Project title</li> <li>Project supervisor</li> <li>Project description, including: background, research objectives, methods, schedule, significance.</li> </ul>
